Dosages are for 10,000 gallons of water. Adjust accordingly. For best results prior to using, adjust pH between 7.6 and 7.8, and total Alkalinity between 120 and 140 ppm.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

The 1lb bottle treats approx. 40,000 gallons.

Using the cap as a tool, a level cap full treats 13,000 gallons. The inner circle treats 8,000 gallons. Broadcast in the areas with the most problems and add the recommended amount of sanitizer.

1. Brush any visible algae.
2. To Clear and Maintain Clear Water: Follow the above directions for use and one of the following: 1 lb. of dry chlorinating compound (calcium hypochlorite or dichloroisocyanurate), 2 lbs. of lithium hypochlorite (35%), 1 gallon of sodium hypochlorite (liquid chlorinating compound) 10-12%, 2 gallons of sodium hypochlorite (liquid chlorinating compound) 5.2%, or 1 lb. of potassium monopersulfate per 10,000 gallons per week.
